

## **Class 10 - Quilting**

### **Rules**

1. One entry per section, per exhibitor
2. Entries to be shown only 2 consecutive years at exhibition
3. Judges are instructed to eliminate any soiled/damaged work
5. Entry must be solely the work of the person entering the competition
6. Entries can be picked-up after 4 p.m. Sunday. Any entries not picked up are not the responsibility of the Dresden Agricultural Society and will be left on the tables.

## **SPECIAL: OAAS CHAMPIONSHIP QUILT COMPETITION**

### **Rules**

- a) Entries must be solely made and hand quilted by the person entering the competition
- b) Quilt must be exhibited and judged by a local Agricultural Society (OAAS member)
- c) Entry quilts must be a minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next level of competition)
- d) All quilts, entered in the competition must be hand quilted
- e) The quilt judged Grand Champion/Best of Show will compete at the OAAS District Meeting in November
- f) A win at the OAAS District Meeting will compete provincially at the OAAS Annual Convention in February
- g) The entry judged Grand Champion/Best of Show at the Convention in February will be declared the "Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Champion Quilt"
- h) The winning quilt at the Provincial competition for the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies will not be eligible to compete in any future District and/or Convention OAAS competition
- i) An exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show/Grand Champion title with a different quilt at different fairs, shall be entitled to enter each winning quilt at the District Competition
- j) If an Exhibitor wins Grand Champion or Best of Show of all eligible quilts at other than his/her own fair, or at more than one fair, the exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which the quilt will be sent to the District competition
- k) Upon making an entry into the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Quilt Competition, the exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition
- l) If using a designer patent, credit must be given on your entry tag

### **Hand Quilting**

2. Appliquéd
3. Rag
4. Quilt any other not listed (i.e. tied quilt)
5. Crib quilt
6. Quilted wall hanging (must have hanging sleeve)
7. Dresden Pattern

## **MACHINE QUILTING**

### **Rules**

- a) Entries must be solely made and machine quilted by the person entering the competition
- b) Quilt must be exhibited and judged by a local Agricultural Society (OAAS member)
- c) Entry quilts must be a minimum of 192" (480cm) measured on the perimeter (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next level of competition)

- d) All quilts, entered in the competition must be hand quilted
- e) The quilt judged Grand Champion/Best of Show will compete at the OAAS District Meeting in November
- f) A win at the OAAS District Meeting will compete provincially at the OAAS Annual Convention in February
- g) The entry judged Grand Champion/Best of Show at the Convention in February will be declared the "Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Champion Quilt"
- h) The winning quilt at the Provincial competition for the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies will not be eligible to compete in any future District and/or Convention OAAS competition
- i) An exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show/Grand Champion title with a different quilt at different fairs, shall be entitled to enter each winning quilt at the District Competition
- j) If an Exhibitor wins Grand Champion or Best of Show of all eligible quilts at other than his/her own fair, or at more than one fair, the exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which the quilt will be sent to the District competition
- k) Upon making an entry into the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Quilt Competition, the exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition
- l) If using a designer patent, credit must be given on your entry tag
