### **No Entry Fee**

Please make sure each child has a completed entry form, exhibitor number from the Secretary, and all entries have a completed entry tag attached.

### **Rules**

- a) Work must be new and made by the pupil (no kits) between September 2010 and August 2011
- b) Children must enter in categories stated for grade appropriate, completed in 2010-11
- c) Only one entry per exhibitor, per section
- d) Entries are to be solely the work of the exhibitor
- e) Entry tags must be filled out and attached to each exhibit.
- f) Miscellaneous categories can be any medium, that the child has done themselves in school or at home
- g) Entries can be picked-up after 4 p.m. Sunday. Any entries not picked up are not the responsibility of the Dresden Agricultural Society and will be left on the tables

### **PRINCE AND PRINCESS CONTEST**

The boy and girl between Grades 5 & 8 with the most points will be named Prince and Princess. The boy and girl must be available for the opening ceremonies as well as Saturday and Sunday for various activities throughout the fair including the parade. Previous winners are not eligible. All applicable categories are Number 21-35 with the exception of the Specials A & B.

**SPECIAL: POSTER COMPETITION**

a) Name and date of fair must be clearly shown on poster

b) Posters must have artist's name, age, phone number, grade and school on the back

c) Entry tag to clearly state what grade level for competition

d) Posters must measure:

minimum 8.5" x 11", without border

maximum 11" x 17", without border

e) Must be mounted & centered on cardstock or Bristol board, exposing on all four sides a 2" border

f) 1st Prize Winner will be required to compete in the District Competition in November and becomes the property of the Dresden Agricultural Society.

- g) Grades up to and including 4 are judged together
- h) Grades 5 – 8 are judged together
- i) Grades 9 – 12 are judged together
- j) Judging criteria: Overall appearance - 20 points
  - Attract & hold attention - 30 points
  - Fair theme is clear - 40 points
  - Quality materials/end product - 10 points
