### **4-H INTERCOUNTY PROGRAM**

All exhibitors must be bonafide 4-H members. Ontario council membership cards will be only proof of membership accepted. Calf must be their 2011 project animal born in 2010 or 2011. Dress code will consist of clean and tidy clothing.

Judging will commence after the 4-H Achievement program. Registration will take place at the judge's stand when announced.

Classes:

1. Showmanship Classes are determined the day of the show based on ages of participants. (Approx. Novice, Junior 10-13, Intermediate 14-16, Senior 17-21)
2. Champion Showmanship
3. Heavy Steer
4. Light Steer
5. Market Heifer
6. Champion Market
7. Breeding Heifer Calf
8. Breeding Heifer Yearling
9. Champion Breeding Heifer

### **MARKET LIVESTOCK**

Steers will be divided according to weight. There will only be two classes. Cattle will be weighed if scales are available, otherwise the judge will split classes in the show ring. Judging will commence after 4-H programs.

\*\*Market heifers are not eligible for breeding classes in the Breeding Program.

\*\*Exhibitor may show/enter only two animals per class.

### **BREEDING PROGRAM**

Judging follows the 4-H Achievement and Inter-county programs.

**Show will consist of purebred and crossbreds showing together numbers permitting.** Papers must be shown upon registration for cattle participating in purebred classes. Tattoos may be checked on show day as well.

\*\*Each bull over 1 year of age must be secured with a ring in the nose with a chain or rope attached.

\*\*Calves shown in cow classes may be split and shown in the calf classes. Calves must be 4 months of age at the time of the show, to be shown.

Prize Money: \$50; \$40; \$35; \$30; \$25

Classes:

1. Bull calf born on or after Jan. 1/11 minimum 4 months of age at time of showing.
2. Bull yearling born April – December of 2010
3. Bull yearling born January – March of 2010
4. Bull born in 2009
5. **Champion Bull – \$60**  
**Reserve Bull - \$ 40**
6. Heifer calf born on or after Jan. 1/11 minimum 4 months of age at the time of showing.
7. Heifer yearling born April – December of 2010
8. Heifer yearling born January – March 2010
9. Cow born in 2009 with her natural 2011 calf at foot, minimum 4 months of age
10. Cow born in 2008 or before with her natural 2010 calf at foot, minimum 4 months of age
11. **Champion Female – \$60**  
**Reserve Female - \$40**
12. Breeders Herd – A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor both sexes to be represented and must have been shown in the previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limit one entry per exhibitor.
