SPECIAL: POSTER COMPETITION

- a) Name and date of fair must be clearly shown on poster
- b) Posters must have artist's name, age, phone number, grade and school on the back
- c) Entry tag to clearly state what grade level for competition
- d) Posters must measure:
 - minimum 8.5" x 11", without border
 - maximum 11" x 17", without border
- e) Must be mounted & centered on cardstock or Bristol board, exposing on all four sides a 2" border
- f) 1st Prize Winner will be required to compete in the District Competition in November and becomes the property of the Dresden Agricultural Society.
- g) Grades up to and including 4 are judged together
- h) Grades 5 – 8 are judged together
- i) Grades 9 – 12 are judged together
- j) Judging criteria: Overall appearance - 20 points
 - Attract & hold attention - 30 points
 - Fair theme is clear - 40 points
 - Quality materials/end product - 10 points
